

**JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW OF SPOKANE**  
**HEIFER SHOW**

Location: Spokane County Fair & Expo Center – Spokane, WA  
Thursday May 3, 2007  
Following Prospect Steer Judging

**Entry Fee - \$12.50 per head      Entry Deadline – April 10, 2007**

**Eligibility**

- General rules for the livestock show apply.
- Health and Brand certificates are required on all out of state steers
- Permit number 91-X397
- On the entry form exhibitors must state which fair the steer is going to and is signed by the exhibitor, FFA advisor, 4-H Leader, Extension Agent, or parent/legal guardian
- Entry Fee is non-refundable
- Heifer must have been born on or after Sept. 1, 2005 to be eligible
- Each exhibitor will be allowed 2 heifers

**Classes**

- Heifers will be classed by age, into as equal groups as possible, by show officials.
- First and Second place winners in each class will be eligible for championship competition.

**Arrival and Show Times**

- Stalls will be available anytime after 9:00 AM Tuesday May 1, 2007
- Heifers must be checked into the show grounds no later and 8:00 PM Tuesday May 1, 2007
- Heifers will be weighed and classified at 8:00 AM Wednesday May 2, 2007
- All participants in this contest are eligible for showmanship classes and premiums
- Heifers will be released after showmanship classes Friday, May 4, 2007

**Awards**

- Eighty percent of the entry fee will be returned to the top fifty percent of the animals in the class, or as deemed appropriate by show officials. Additional; prize money from sponsors may be added.
- The Champion steer will receive  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the collected sponsorship money
- The Reserve Champion steer will receive  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the collected sponsorship money
- Premiums will be paid on conformation and showmanship classes.
